Committee updates:

• Community plan – Mrs Christine Paynter updated on the actions within the community plan:

• Play park update – The annual fun day will be Sunday 16th July. All welcome.

Village Maintenance:

• Handyman – Robert has been strimming and cutting back briars so that pavements are kept clear together with hedge cutting. An average of 1.5 hours per week has been worked and he has advised he doesn't want to work anymore than this.

• **Defib** –. The cabinet and defib is with Mr David Hopkins who will make David arrangements for fitting. The clerk is to arrange some training dates. Hopkins/

• **CCTV** – the clerk, Chairman and Mr Boyd met with a concerned member of the public Clerk and alleviated any concerns. CCC have advised suitable signs are to be erected and have quoted £1500 for these including the posts, it was agreed to use the template but to get Michael Murray to build at a cheaper cost. CCC have advised that the signs can only be erected to the entrances of the village where the cameras will be located.
